

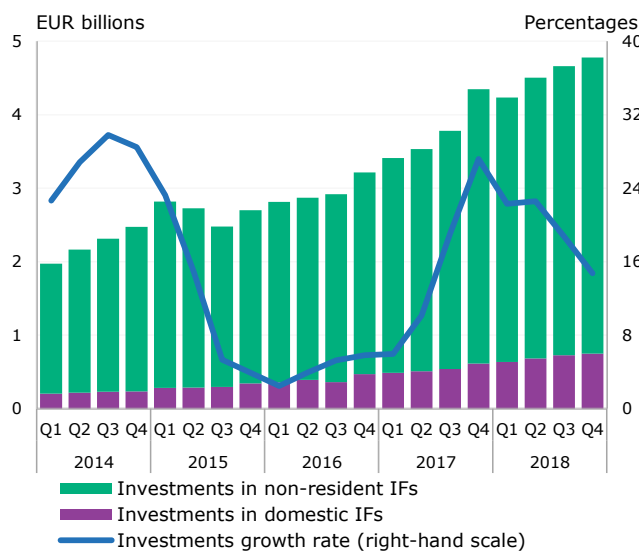

Lithuanian investors choose non-resident investment funds

Financial accounts data for Q4 2018 published today show that the **assets of Lithuania's institutional sectors in investment funds** amounted to €4.8 billion at the end of 2018, a year-on-year increase of 14.8%. Assets in non-resident investment funds amounted to €4.0 billion. They were four times larger than assets in domestic investment funds, which amounted to €0.8 billion at the end of 2018.

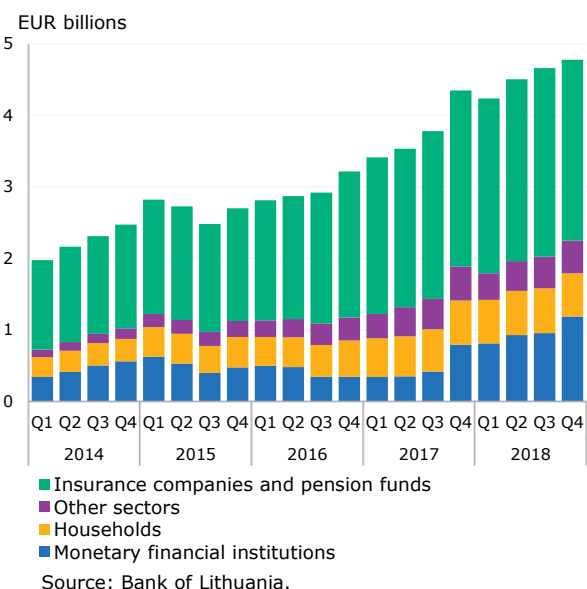
Insurance companies and pension funds were the biggest investors in investment funds. Their assets in investment funds amounted to €2.5 billion at the end of 2018.
